

Year One maths homework



13 th September	<p>Using the one hundred number square take turns in covering a number 1-20. Look at the numbers one more and one less than the covered number. Guess what the number is underneath the counter.</p> <p>Find a number on the number square up to 20. Cover the numbers either side, guess the covered numbers which will be one more and one less than the number in the middle.</p> <p>Extension: Use numbers up to 50 and then 100.</p>
20 th September	<p>Play snakes and ladders. Talk about the numbers that you land on. Talk about counting on/forwards/more/more than.</p>
27 th September	<p>Work out all the different ways of adding two numbers up to 10 using objects. Record the different ways in your homework book e.g $3+7=10$.</p> <p>Extension: Try and do the same activity up to 20.</p>
4 th October	<p>Play double trouble! Use your fingers or objects to double numbers up to 10. Record your workings e.g $4+4=8$.</p> <p>Extension: Double numbers up to 20.</p>
11 th October	<p>Play adding pairs using a pack of playing cards. Each pair of cards has to add to 10 for the person to keep it.</p> <p>Extension: Play snap where each player has to be really quick at adding the numbers to 10!</p>
18 th October	<p>Using practical equipment and the one hundred number square practise counting in 2's to 20.</p> <p>Extension: Try and carry on counting in 2's beyond 20.</p>
