Sort the above words into three groups and practise reading them. Encourage your child to say and blend the phonemes together first and then say the whole word
Can you find any more words to add to the groups?

Challenge – try and include some of these words in a sentence.

Maths – Number Relationships

This week we have been using what we know to help us work out other sums. For example, if $3+4=7$ then $4+3$ must also make 7, and it then follows that $7-4$ is 3, and $7-3$ is 4.
Start with any number sentence and see if you can find the other number sentences that relate to it.

$3+4=7$, $4+3=7$, $7-3=4$, $7-4=3$
