### Spelling Activities

Your homework each week will be to learn the 10 spellings above. You will need to choose an activity to do each day. On the following day select another activity, and so on. Please do this five times in a week. **Please ask your parents to check that you have written your spellings accurately. Thank you.**

In my experience, your spelling ability gets so much better if you practise every day, rather than doing all five activities on the last day!

### Reading

You should read every day. It is so important for you to read at home with an adult. If your parents are able to ask questions about what you have read from **the list**, this will greatly increase your **comprehension skills**, even if you are a 'good' reader. Please ask your parents to sign your yellow Reading Record Book when they have heard you read. Thank you.

### Maths

Learn your multiplication tables. You will be assessed every week and will progress on to the next stage once you have completed your challenge successfully three times in less than 5 minutes. You are on planet\_\_\_\_\_. The test may have a few more columns in certain challenges.
