10 th January	<p>Use two pence pieces to count in twos to twenty. Say all the two times tables to twenty in order. 17 th January	<p>Say all the three times tables to thirty in order. Record all the three times tables to thirty in order.</p> <p>Challenge: Ask the children their three times tables not in the correct order.</p> <p>Example: $4 \times 3 = ?$ $10 \times 3 = ?$ $3 \times 3 = ?$</p>
24 th January	<p>Using the photocopied ruler provided measure ten objects around the house in cm. Put the objects in order from shortest to longest length. Put the objects in two groups, more and less than ten cm.</p>
31 st January	<p>Ask an adult to help you find ten bottles that contain liquid measured in millilitres and litres. Put the bottles in order from smallest to largest capacity. Put the objects in two groups, more and less than 500 ml.</p>
7 th February	<p>Ask an adult to help you find ten containers that are measured in grams and kilograms. Put the containers in order from lightest to heaviest. Put the objects in two groups, more and less than 200g.</p>
