18 th April	<p>Position and direction-</p> <p>Our first topic this term is all about movements, positions and direction. Fill in the stem sentences in your homework book. Then complete the next table with answers (see sheet).</p>
25 th April	<p>Position and direction- this week we've learnt about the terms clockwise and anticlockwise. Draw your favourite book character facing forwards, then after a quarter turn, half turn and full turn clockwise. Repeat with anticlockwise. Extension- what would your character look like after $\frac{3}{4}$ turn clockwise and anticlockwise?</p>
2 nd May	<p>Reasoning and problem solving- This week we've been looking at how we can create patterns with shapes. At home create your own sets of patterns, e.g. 2 squares, 2 triangles, 1 circle and repeat. Extension- see if you can use colours as well as shapes in your pattern.</p>
9 th May	<p>Measurement-time- Using your knowledge of the 5 times tables, label the times on the clock faces.</p> <p>Extension- create some more of your own and label.</p>
